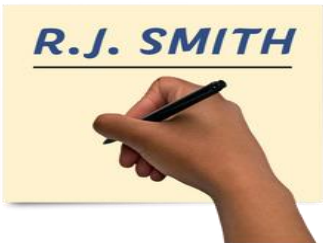
Some people had been scammed during lockdown.

It can be good to 'google' phone numbers.



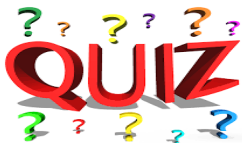
Devon People First said to be careful with e-mails, such as e-mails from Amazon.
